FORT COLLINS, Colo., February 21, 2018 – Bohemian Foundation invites nonprofits to attend information sessions about Muse, a responsive, competitive grant program offered by Bohemian Foundation's Music Programs.

Muse, established in 2017, provides support to organizations that have music as their primary focus, or that have a music-centered program. Through Muse, Bohemian Foundation makes awards up to \$20,000 to eligible 501(c)(3) organizations serving Larimer and Weld Counties. Applications are accepted twice per year. Funding requests must align with at least one of Bohemian Foundation's Music Programs goals: to provide youth with encouragement and opportunities to express themselves through music; to help musicians and music-related businesses grow and develop; and to increase performances of live contemporary music.
